Offered by	⇒	The Swiss Government through the Federal Commission for Scholarships for Foreign Students FCS
Objectives	⇒	To enable selected applicants to undertake a Postdoctoral Research in one of the 10 Swiss Public Universities, the two Swiss Federal Institutes of Technology, the public teaching and research institutes and the Universities of applied sciences

Validity	⇒	The Scholarship is only valid for a full time Postdoctoral Research in Switzerland. It is not valid for mixed Postdoctoral Research (part time in Switzerland and part time in a third country)
Target Group	⇒	Highly qualified postdoctoral researchers from all academic fields
Duration	⇒	12 months (renewable maximum 6 months)
Amount and additional	⇒	The scholarship amounts to a monthly payment of 3500 Swiss Francs ⇒ Exemption of the tuition fees (except for EPFL)

<p>allowances</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Mandatory Swiss Health insurance paid by the FCS (for non-EU or EFTA grantees only) ⇒ A lump sum for air fare for non-European grantees only (provided at the end of the scholarship) ⇒ Special 300 Swiss Francs lodging allowance (paid once at the beginning of the scholarship) ⇒ 1 year half-fare public transportation card ⇒ Counseling and various trips, dinners and sight seeing tours organized for Swiss Government Scholarship holders
<p>Eligibility Criteria and specific conditions</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ PhD degree ⇒ There cannot be a gap of more than 5 years between the award of the PhD and the application deadline ⇒ Applicants who are in Switzerland for more than 1 year at the beginning of the scholarship are not eligible ⇒ Applicants must provide a letter (e-mail) from a Professor from the Swiss host institution stating that he/she is willing to supervise the postdoctoral research ⇒ Applicants must have a research proposal including a timeframe (this is the central piece of the application. The applicant must devote all required attention to it) ⇒ Applicants must be in command of the necessary language skills required for the Postdoctoral Research ⇒ Applicants who have already benefited from a Swiss Government Scholarship are not eligible to apply for a second scholarship
<p>Application Procedure</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ The application package can be obtained by e-mail from the China Scholarship Council in Beijing. ⇒ The deadline for the submission of applications is 20/03/2013 ⇒ Applications have to be submitted in 3 copies (hard copies only)
<p>Application Time Framework</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ Opening of the call: 01/03/2013 ⇒ Application Deadline: 20/03/2013 ⇒ Selection Interview, ask: China Scholarship Council ⇒ Beginning of the scholarship: 16.09.2014
<p>Application documents (Please provide 3 sets of copies on <u>A4 paper</u>. Please do not staple the documents and/or put them into plastic sheets or binders).</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⇒ The FCS 2014-2015 official application form (typed and printed). <u>No handwritten forms will be accepted</u> ⇒ Copies of all university certificates and grade-sheets (all copies must be attested, and translated if originals are not in English, German, French or Italian. Attestations can be done by the University or a Government Officer. ⇒ 2 letters of recommendation from Professors in the applicants field (<u>use exclusively</u> the official reference form provided with the application package) ⇒ A complete research proposal (max. 5 pages), <u>use exclusively</u> the official research proposal form provided with the application package ⇒ A motivation letter (max. 2 pages) ⇒ A full curriculum vitae with list of academic publications ⇒ A copy of the confirmation from a Professor at the intended Swiss University that he/she is willing to supervise the Postdoctoral Research. ⇒ A health certificate (<u>use exclusively</u> the official health certificate provided with the application package) ⇒ A copy of the passport (main page with personal data)
